Please find below important dates:

Tuesday 18th June 6.00 – 7.00pm. **Parents only**. This is an opportunity to gather information, meet your child's teacher, SENDco and Headteacher. There will be time to ask questions. Please RSVP by emailing the office: admin@qeorgestreet.herts.sch.uk

Wednesday 26th June 9.30 – 11.00am Stay and play (parents welcome to stay all or part of the session).

Thursday 11th July 9.30am – 2.00pm **No parents.** This is a chance for your child to start to become familiar with the environment, some routines and the adults who will be supporting your child in Reception. **YOUR CHILD WILL NEED A PACKED LUNCH AND NAMED WATER BOTTLE**

If your child already attends George Street Nursery there is the option to bring your child into nursery at the usual time (9am) and our nursery staff will bring your child into Reception at 9.30am. Some parents will want to bring their child to the Reception class for 9.30am. Please can you let us know what you plan to do.

Wednesday 4th September 8.45am. Your child's first day in George Street Reception class.
