



Halloween Disco Friday 7th November 2025

KS1 & Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception): 4.30pm until 6.00pm

KS2: 6.15pm until 7.45pm

All tickets £6 each

We will be holding a Halloween disco on Friday 7th November. Children are invited to dress up in Halloween costumes but please remember that some children may be scared by costumes or accessories that are too frightening. We would ask that children do not wear masks or bring any weapon type accessories or props.

Included in the price is a drink and a hot dog. Nail painting (peel off) will be available throughout (£1 each) a lucky dip (£1 a go) and tattoos (50p each) Foam LED lights (£2 each) and light up glasses (from £1) Sweets will also be available to purchase after each disco (from 50p-£1.50). We ask you to kindly book your child's ticket by 3rd November at the latest. Payment can be made via the school gateway app. We will not be sending out paper tickets so once you have made payment, your child will be on the register to attend. If you have not made payment, your child will not be admitted to the disco on the night.

Please note: All Nursery & Reception children must be accompanied by an adult, due to numbers we kindly ask that just 1 adult stays, this person can supervise a maximum of 3 children. If a child doesn't have an adult they will not be permitted to stay at the disco. (No siblings including babes in arms). If your child is in year 1 or 2 you will not be able to stay. This is because the hall and dining room becomes too over crowded with adults and overwhelms many children. You will be asked to leave if your child is above reception age. KS2 will not be allowed in until the doors open at 6.15pm. The Office doors are for pick up only. KS2 children, who have siblings attending the earlier disco, can wait in the Y5 classroom where a member of staff will supervise them until the start of the KS2 disco.

Please note the KS2 starts at 6.15pm and finishes at 7.45pm.

As always, volunteers are needed to help at both discos so please let the office know if you can offer help. Your help is gratefully appreciated. Thank you for your continued support.
